WORKBOOKS, BAGS, & ETC.

CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

This policy at Shores Community Church requires that anyone working with minors (ages 0-18 years of age) go through an in-depth application process, background check, and training. No issues precipitated this, but we want to be faithful, careful stewards and protectors of the children God has entrusted to us. As a result, every AWANA worker has been through this process.

DROP OFF/PICK UP

Both times can be very chaotic at Shores Community Church! The biggest problem we have is at the end of clubs, making sure that each child is with the adult responsible for them.

Please be prompt in picking up your children at 7:30pm. Our workers in every age group also have children that they must go sign out.
